

MSJ Photography returns with October's installment of its unique project, the Rent-a-Wall series of exhibitions. Intended as a convenient and inexpensive way to display photography in almost any setting, Rent-a-Wall allows anyone to display their photographs on MSJ's collapsible "wall" for a reasonably nominal fee.

Originally initiated in September, the first Rent-a-Wall exhibition featured pictures relating to the celebration of Aidilfitri, and started off as a moderate success with a turnout of 30 photographs. October's wall features over twice that number, with 68 photos currently displayed at the South City Walk of City Mall.

Expected to be on display from October 19 to 25, 2009, this month's photos are drawn from a pool of talents who do not necessarily consider themselves photographers, from charity organisers to fashion professionals.

MSJ's Gerry Kong intends to maintain this thread, explaining that anyone who wants to "promote art, life or dreams through photography" is more than welcome to have their work displayed on the Rent-a-Wall. He adds his belief in uniting the strengths of his talented contributors, in the spirit of 1 Malaysia, and of course, the concept of "Sabah boleh" (Sabah can do it).

Kong anticipates the collection of photographs to double again in next month's exhibit, to be held at the Asia City Complex from November 9 to 15, 2009. This month's Rent-a-Wall also aims to reward its best photographer, selected through votes from the public. The best photographer stands to win a prize care of Investline Sdn. Bhd.
