This Murut warrior came from Pensiangan and died in 1904. He was killed during a fracas with the British North Borneo Company's soldiers at Sungai Selangit near Pensiangan. They lost the battle but Antanom gained a place in history. The Rundum rebellion will never be forgotten.

He is considered a hero, which he was as he dared to face the bullets of the colonists.

He is remembered with a memorial in Tenom.

Rundum lies almost forgotten but not the deeds of this warrior.

The Murut are an indigenous ethnic group living mostly in the South central part of Sabah.
