

Artemis dock at Kota Kinabalu

A PASSENGER Cruise Ship registered in Bermuda was here at the Kota Kinabalu Port yesterday. The 230 metre long vessel with 1260 passengers stopped from 8am to 5pm, allowing tourists to shop in the State Capital for a while.

According to Staff Captain Sarah Breton the ship was on an-80 day trip round the world, with the next destination being Brunei.

The passengers were mostly British and Australians, she says. The ship started its journey in Southampton, England and will return there in February after its cruise is over.

The ship was currently touring Africa and Asian countries on their 207 world cruise itinerary.
