 - 1 Tunku Abdul Rahman Marine Park - Malaysia's premier marine park comprises of five islands - Gaya, Sapi, Manukan, Mamutik and Sulug
 - 1 Monsopiad Cultural Village - the house of skulls and legend of head hunter
 - 1 Kinabalu Park - Mt. Kinabalu World Heritage Site
 - 1 Poring Hot Springs - hot springs, rainforest canopy walk
