Thrill seekers can gear up for 15-minute paint-war battles at Area 21 Paintball in Penampang (that can accommodate up to 18 players) or the largest paintball field in Sabah located at the Outdoor Development Center, University Malaysia Sabah. Players can choose from a variety of scenarios including Total Elimination (victory is gained when all players of the rival team is eliminated); Save the Prisoner (a soldier from each side is taken hostage and needs to be safely brought back to home base); Capture the Flag (troops may either completely eliminate the opposing team or sneak across the borderline and return with a stolen flag); Centre Flag (the flag placed in the middle of the field must be transported to the enemy's ground); and many more.
