### Mataking Island Opens First Underwater Post Office in Malaysia



The Reef Dive Resort at Mataking Island, off the coast of Semporna, officially launched the opening of the first underwater post office in Malaysia on 19 March with the sinking of MATAKING 1, a 40-year old wooden cargo ship which is no longer in use. The sinking of the ship will create an artificial reef, home to a variety of marine creatures. A mailbox is placed on the wheel house of this ship wreck and divers can 'post' their letters and postcards underwater.
