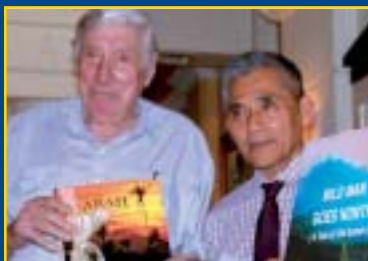
TM Named Title Sponsor Again for Upcoming Mt. Kinabalu International Climbathon
