Then, different coloured serdang leaves are pasted and sewn onto the body to complete the product. Decorative and handy, they make great storage for any living space.

RATTAN TABLE MATS



These versatile rattan mats are produced by the Kadazandusun community of Kota Belud, a bustling district located along the west coast of Sabah. The full round rattan version is sturdier while the half rattan mat has a more lightweight feel. The square mats can be used for decorative purposes or as placemats for the dining table. The mats retain their natural hue, which is light beige. Perfect to give your home a rustic Sabahan feel!
